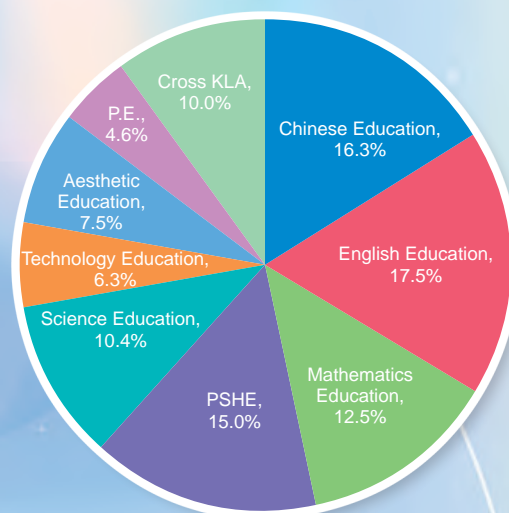

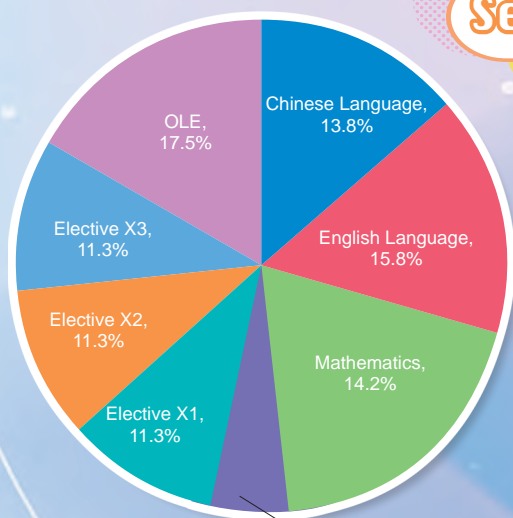

Academic Performance of S6 Students (2022-2023)

Our students once again reaped impressive results in the 2023 HKDSE. 93.6% (110) of our students met the basic entrance requirement for admission to publicly-funded undergraduate programmes (33222), well above the territory-wide day school figure (42.4%). A special mention is given to Jason Siu Tsz Yin (6B), who achieved a top score of six 5** and two 5*. The results of the best 18 performing students with 27 marks or above (best 5 and best 6) are as follows:

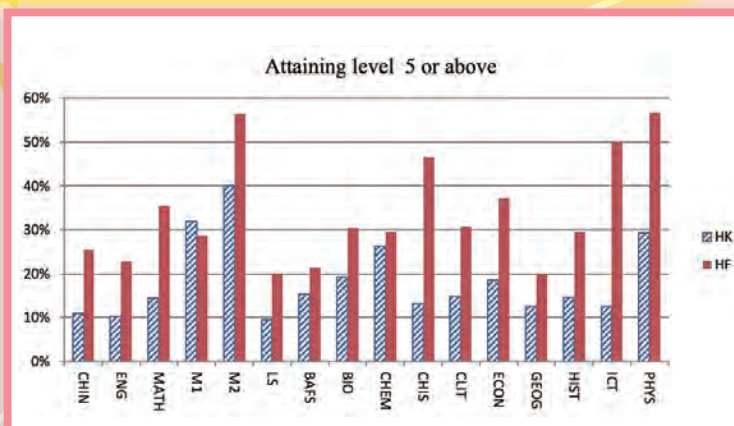
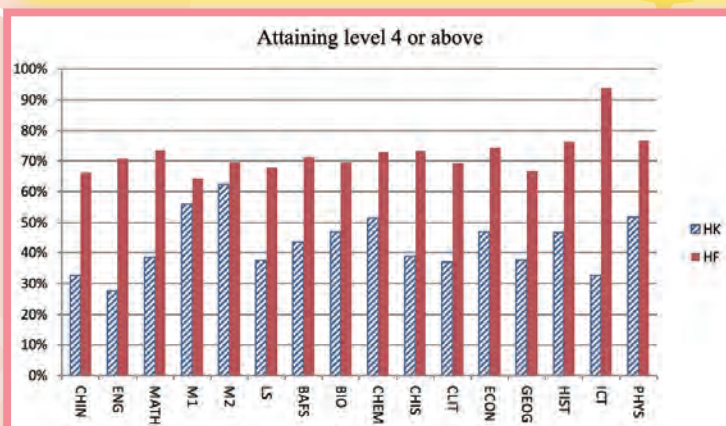

Impressively, the percentage of students attaining level 4 and level 5 far surpasses the territory percentage.

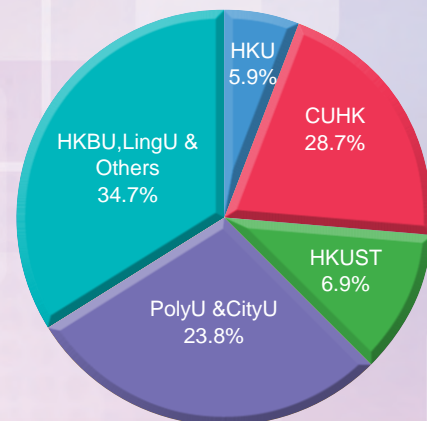


JUPAS OFFERS (2023)

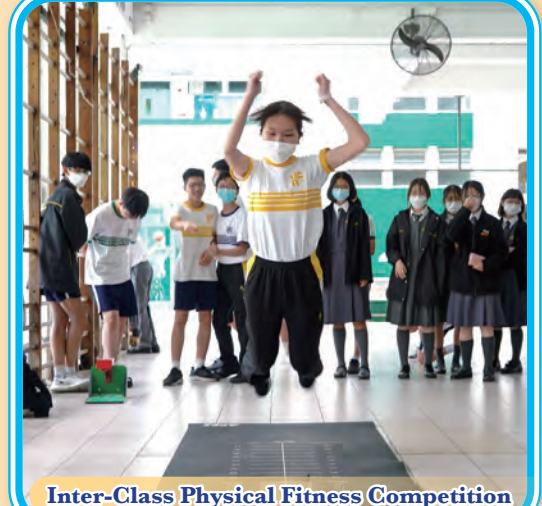

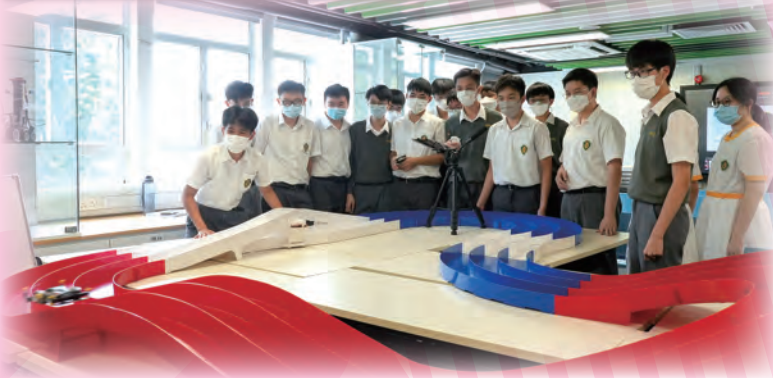
