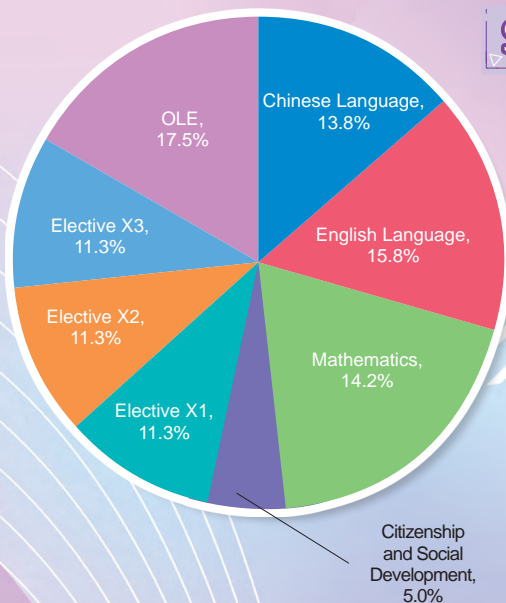
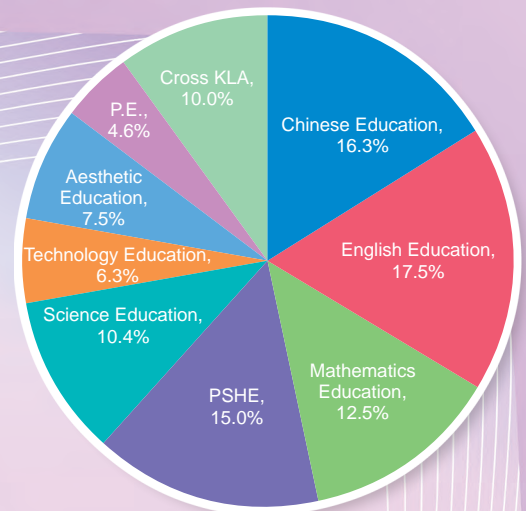

Academic Performance of S6 Students (2023-2024)

Our students once again reaped impressive results in the 2024 HKDSE. 87.0% (94) of our students met the basic entrance requirement for admission to publicly-funded undergraduate programmes (332A2), well above the territory-wide day school figure (44.9%). 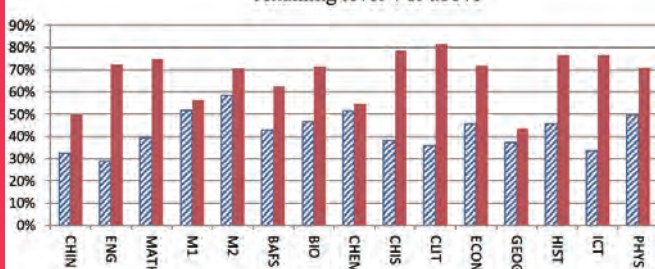

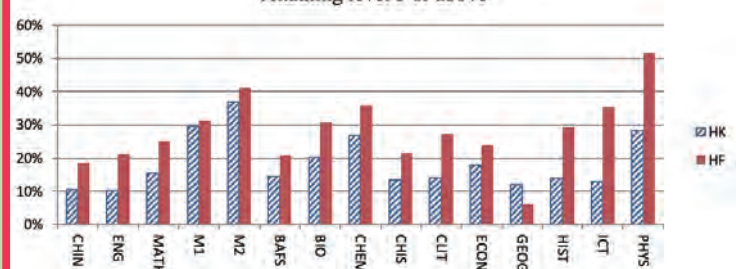


Impressively, the percentage of students attaining level 4 and level 5 far surpasses the territory percentage.

Attaining level 5 or above

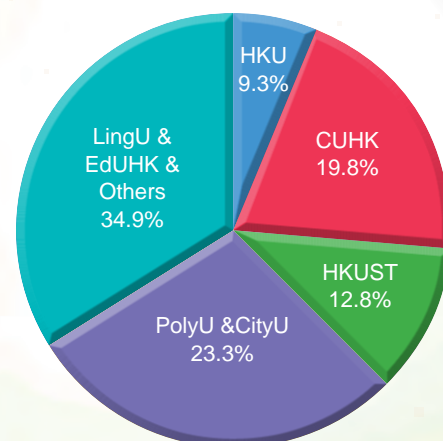

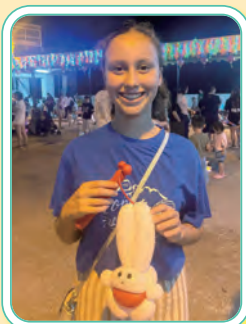
